What's this all about?

The Recycle Regatta is a fun event that helps students focus on different and creative ways they can reuse and recycle "waste" to help the environment. On the day of the event, Recycle Regatta crews race their recycled boats against their peers over a 50-yard course. Races are divided by age group, each with a different starting time, and mixed age crews will race with the older age group.

3rd - 5th grade 9 a.m. 6th - 8th grade 10 a.m. 9th - 12th grade 11 a.m.

Adult or Open 12 p.m. (children in grades K-2 may enter this race if accompanied by parents or guardians)

Spa Beach is located on the north side of The Pier in St. Petersburg. The address is 615 2nd Ave. N.E., St. Petersburg, FL.

The Rules:

- At least 70% of the materials used to build the watercraft must come from the waste stream (things that would normally be put in the trash). The remaining 30% of the materials can be new (tape, nails, etc.).
- Your choices are as wide as your imagination, but please do not use any glass or anything toxic. Plastic 2-liter bottles work well, as do milk containers, scrap wood, drums or cafeteria trays! All styrofoam must be securely contained or sealed so it cannot break loose. Old floatation devices may **NOT** be used to construct your watercraft. For instance, an old surfboard or boogie board cannot be used as the base for your recycled boat. After the race, teams should put recyclable portions of their boats in the "Recyclin' Roadie" trailer.
- The watercraft must be propelled by human or sail power. This may include oars or pedals, but no motors and no trained dolphins. Crew members must power their boat from inside or on top of the craft. Pushing or pulling the boats by swimming is **NOT** allowed.
- All crew members must bring and wear a US Coast Guard approved life vest.
- This event is open to all ages, however, crew members under 18 must have a parent or guardian present. One adult for each boat must be prepared to be in the water to help hold the boat at the starting line. No pushing, please!
- A separate Entry Form and Release Agreement must be completed for each crew member. Please send in all the entry forms for your crew together.

Release Agreement
